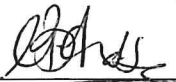

Affidavit

I, the undersigned Charlynnne Blanche Arendse hereby declare under oath as follows:

1. I am an adult female currently employed at the Metropolitan Municipality of the City of Cape Town and delegated as a Deputy Information Officer in terms of section 17(3) of the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000.
2. The facts contained in this affidavit are within my personal knowledge and I am authorised to depose to it.
3. I confirm that we received a request for access to information in terms of the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000.
4. The request for records relates to a variety of records received in respect of traffic baseline reports, traffic impact assessments and related records in respect of the King David Mowbray Golf Course redevelopment, inclusive of other records.
5. I sent the request to the Urban Mobility directorate in the City of Cape Town, which directorate forwarded the request to the Property Development department in the City of Cape Town's Economic Growth directorate.
6. In this department I liaised with Mr. Shelton Nhiwatiwa, Property Development Manager stationed in Property Development where searches for the records were conducted.
7. The subject matter of this affidavit is in respect of records 'd', 'e' and 'f'.
8. According to Mr. Nhiwatiwa, the searches revealed that records in item 'd' do not exist. He confirmed that the engagements with the relevant transport authorities on the question of a new station, is at an early and exploratory stage.
9. He further informed me that the records in item 'e' also do not exist because no formal commitments of any kind has been concluded in so far as it relates to the City of Cape Town, the Passenger Rail Agency of South Africa and the Western Cape Department of Transport and Public Works. Consequently, these records do not exist.
10. In respect of records in item 'f', Ms Nhiwatiwa informed me that these records have not been incorporated into the City of Cape Town's plans and budgets. He further indicated that commitments to its implementation has not been made.
11. Against the background of the response in respect of item 'f', these records therefore also do not exist.
12. In view of the responses received, there are reasonable grounds for believing that the records which form the subject matter of this affidavit, do not exist.
13. It is therefore not possible to give access to the requested records.
